In the Ducks we also introduce children to more planned learning but always with a focus on play. Our expert staff, teach additional skills where we carefully observe and encourage correct development in a social and peer group environment.

Toddlers learn best through happy structured play where they are encouraged to use their new-found movement and speech to the full.

Our objective is to hear laughter and encourage sharing, to stimulate development at each child's own pace and to work in partnership with parents to offer the best start to their child's learning.

Constant communication and accurate feedback will be given and you will have a designated key worker nurse who will be your named contact. Each nursery room has a phone so that you can call anytime for regular updates.

We call our two to three year olds 'Cygnets' and boy are they up for fun and learning. When you visit these areas of the nurseries you can feel the vibrant pulse and endless energy of the children. This is channeled via our specialist nurses into learning by exploring indoors and out.

Happiness is the key and the rate at which our children learn is phenomenal, hence why it is so important that they learn in the right way guided by fully trained staff.

In some cases where parents aren't working or are in full time education, etc children are entitled to **15 HOURS FREE** childcare, each week of term time.

At The Cedars Nursery we offer both term time and a more flexible system so that your child may attend every week of the year. Please ask for details.

We call our three and four year olds 'Swans', and the time your child spends in our pre-school, as a 'Swan', is so important where we nurture and prepare them for mainstream school.

Our specialist Teachers and Nurses teach essential skills under the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (see pages 8 & 9) and the children love it. Cookery, home corners, modelling, games and activities are intermingled with numeracy and literacy so that learning is always fun.

As with their physical build, a child's learning accelerates as they gain a better command of language and understanding.

As your child has no limit to their imagination, we have no budget limit to our creative resources and almost every day your child will present you with something new they have proudly created. Indoors or outside (see page 10), the Swans create an energy that only they can, buzzing with desire to learn everything - such a great age.

are individuals first and each has a unique profile of abilities

At The Cedars Nurseries all our planning starts with observing each child so that we can plan individual development and learning into our nursery schedules and routines.

we start with the child

We observe each child to find out about their needs, their interests and what they can already do, noting specific responses in different situations analysing these observations and highlighting the child's achievements or their need for additional support. We then involve parents as part of the ongoing observation, learning and assessment process.

our planning

Our planning covers short, medium and long term needs so we can quickly put the principles of the EYFS into practice. This planning will support each child's development and learning path.

Our planning always follows the same pattern – observe, analyse, and use what we have found out about the child so that we can plan for the next steps in their development and learning.

continuous

We gather information from each child and their parent/carers so that we can cover all aspects of a child's development including health, education and social development.

This process is continuous and forms the individual learning path for each child. This learning path is split into activities under the seven headings opposite.

These give us the areas in which we can ensure that each step in a child's development is taking place in each area of learning and in relationship to others, ie that social and emotional development is running together with physical and communication, etc.

effective practice

When we are planning we always remember that children learn from everything, even things you haven't planned for – such as their first fall of snow. By observing this reaction as part of the daily routine we can quickly react and develop the 'what next' for individuals and groups of children so that we make the most of this new learning adventure.

Planned flexibility at this level leads to a more effective learning experience and to a more rounded child. This requires expert understanding and guidance from our qualified teaching staff.

everyone works together

Ensuring flexibility in planning for the group, while keeping a focus on a child's individual and present learning needs, or interests and achievements really works in ensuring that each child gets the most out of nursery.

Then by creating records that are clear and accessible to everyone, including parent/carers, we can be sure that the good work is continued and built upon at home.

none of us is as smart as all of us

We regularly meet to consider all the factors that affect children's development and learning led by the child's keyworker. We take into account the personal views of parent/carers and practitioners to ensure that these are reflected in each child's records.

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) is an excellent framework and has been fully incorporated into the operation of The Cedars Nursery. It is one of the reasons we are accepted by many as one of the foremost providers of top quality care and learning.
